

# Arches, Headers and Sills, and Quions



### **Arches:**

A curved stone structure resting on supports at both extremities used to sustain the weight of the stone above, or an open space. The appearance of the arch construction can take on a variety of appearances depending on the shape and size of the stone installed.

### **Headers and Sills:**

Headers are a series of stones or masonry unit that overlaps an opening like a window or door, and two or more adjacent wyther of masonry to tie them together. Sills are a flat stone used under windows, doors and other masonry openings.

Headers and sills are custom fabricated most often from limestone and sandstone products. The pieces are custom fabricated to your dimensions. These details are often referred to as window and door accessories or dressings.

### **Quions:**

Quions are stones at the corner of a wall or placed around an opening emphasized by size, projection, rustification or by a different finish.

Quions are custom fabricated most often from limestone and sandstone products. Quion Stone are truly an added touch of detail to any opening.
